





READ FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS PRIOR TO INSTALLING THEKOBI LED T8 REWIRETO ENSURE SAFETY AND PROPER OPERATION





Important Safety Notices:

- In order to perform the installation, we recommend you contact a licensed electrician who will follow the NEC code, as well as local electrical codes.
- 2. Existing fluorescent tubes contain hazardous substances. Do not break the tubes. Safety glasses and gloves are recommended.
- 3. Never attempt to disassemble the Kobi Electric LED T8 Rewire. The product has no serviceable parts inside.

Instructions

- Turn off the circuit breaker and AC switch before working on the light.
- 2. If necessary, remove the cover from the light fixture according to the manufacturer's instructions.
- Carefully remove the old glass tubes and dispose of them according to federal, state, and local laws.
- 4. Ensure the light fixture is designed to accommodate a bi-pin fluorescent tube before installing the Kobi Electric LED T8 Rewire. The Kobi Electric LED T8 Rewire is compatible with light fixtures designed for T8 and T12 diameter tubes.
- 5. Ensure that the fixture is not an emergency battery supplied fixture. If it is an emergency battery supplied fixture, disconnect the battery.
- 6. Remove the ballast.
- Install the Kobi Electric T8 LED in the light fixture. Ensure that the tubes are seated firmly.
- 8. Put the cover back on the fixture according to the manufacturer's instructions.
- 9. Turn on the circuit breaker and AC switch.
- 10. Turn on the ON / OFF switch to verify proper operation.
