Not Compatible	One or more of the following observed: Major flickering at various points, significant audible noise, no dimming range, does not turn off.
Bad	One or more of the following observed: Some flickering observed at various points, audible noise may be present, dimming not smooth.
Good	One or more of the following observed: Minor flickering at some point may exist. Dead travel may exist, which means there may be periods of time when the slider (or other form of control button) is moved without affecting the light level. These periods of dead travel are minor and most of the time not visible. Minor audible noise.
Best	Most of the following observed: No flickering, minimal audible noise (typically less than 25 dBA), wide dimming range - can dim down to 20% or less of light output.
High End (H.E.) Dead Travel	Determines how much, if any, dead travel exists at the top and bottom of the dimmer's range. Dead travel is when the slider can be moved without affecting the light level.
