### WARNING, CAUTION, SAFETY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

#### WARNING

- Installation, service, and maintenance of luminaries should be performed by a qualified licensed electrician.
- Follow these instructions and notes to ensure that the product is installed and operated in a safe condition.
- There are tubes, operation instructions, and field applied double-ended or single-ended applications labels in this retrofit kit.

#### CAUTION

- Do not make or alter any holes in the wiring enclosure or electrical components during installation.
- Type B Lamp – intended for operation in luminaries with traditional fluorescent-type lamp holders wired directly to the branch circuit. This includes both factory-wired luminaries as well as those converted for this purpose under a retrofit program.
- Not for emergency lighting.
- Installers should not disconnect existing wires from the lamp holder terminals to make new connections at the lamp holder terminals. Instead, installers should cut existing lamp holder leads away from the lamp holder and wire new electrical connections to the lamp holder lead wires by employing applicable connectors.
- Install this kit only in the luminaires that have the construction features and dimensions shown in the photography and/or drawings and where the input rating of the retrofit kit does not exceed the input rating of the luminaire.
- To avoid a potential fire or shock hazard, do not use this retrofit kit in luminaires employing shunted bi-pin lampholders. NOTE: Shunted lamp holders are found only in fluorescent luminaires with Instant-start ballasts. Instant-start ballasts can be identified by the words “Instant Start” or “I.S.” marked on the ballast. This designation may be in the form of a statement pertaining to the ballast itself, or may be combined with the marking for the lamps with what the ballast is intended to be used, for example F40T12/IS. For more information, contact the LED luminaire retrofit kit manufacturer.
- THIS RETROFIT KIT IS ACCEPTED AS A COMPONENT OF A LUMINARIE WHERE THE SUITABILITY OF THE COMBINATION SHALL BE DETERMINED BY AUTHORITIES HAVING JURISDICTION.
- LED Retrofit Kit installation requires knowledge of luminaires electrical systems. If not qualified, do not attempt installation. Contact a qualified electrician.
- Only use the control provided with or specified by these instructions to control this lamp. This lamp will not operate properly when connected to a standard (incandescent) dimmer or dimmer control. Only operate with specific dimmer PLTSPA manufactured by PLT Solutions.
- The units covered by this report were intended to retrofit surface mount, Type IC or non-IC recessed mount Listed fluorescent luminaries that use a maximum of four tubular lamps. The minimum lamp compartment dimensions are listed below:

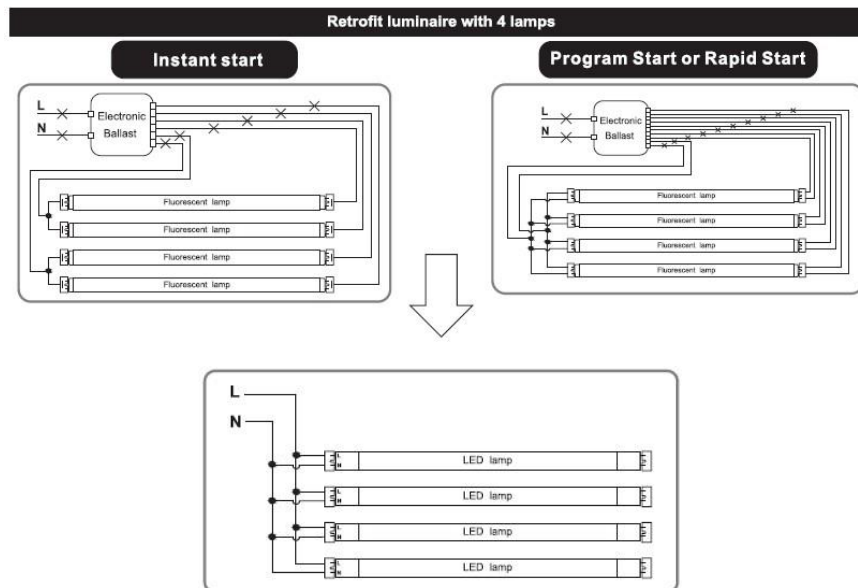
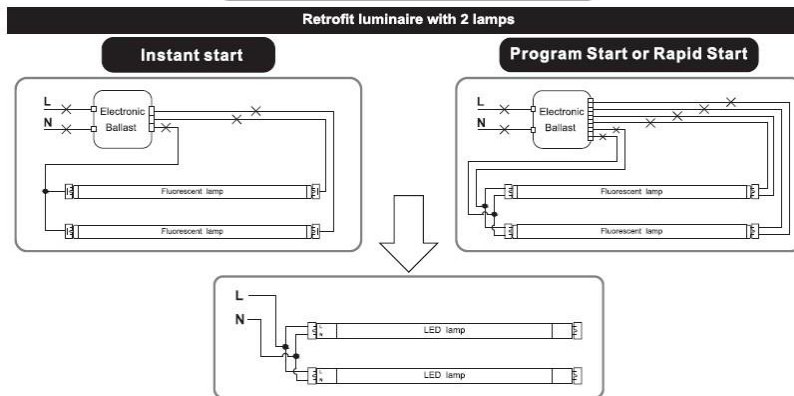
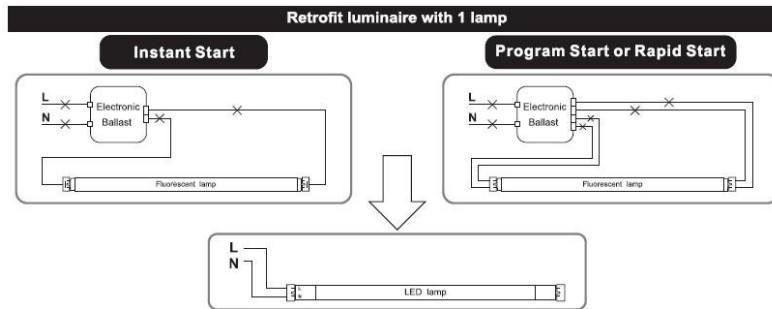

The below ballast wiring represents typical configurations. The actual ballast wiring varies according to ballast model. The socket should be non-shunted.





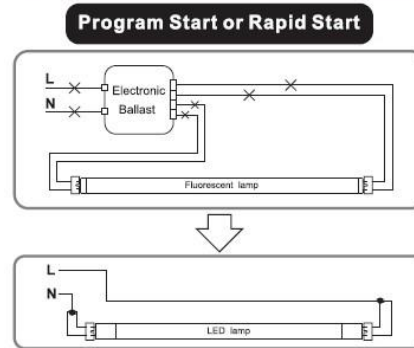
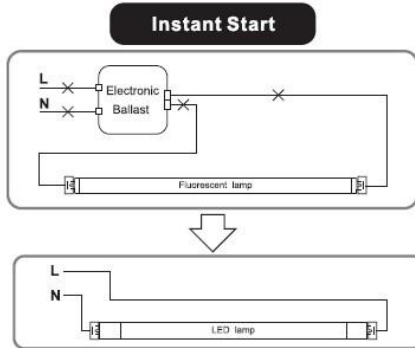

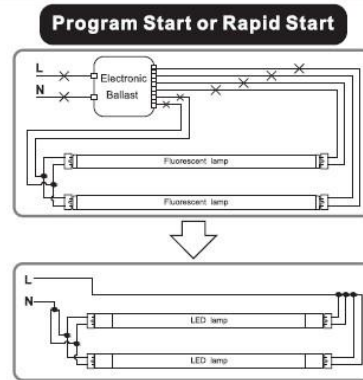
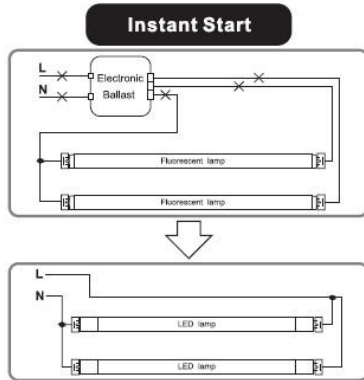
### Double-ended Wiring Instructions

The bellow ballast wiring represents typical configurations. The actual ballast wiring varies according to the ballast model. If the sockets are in good conditions, you do not need to change them to change them, regardless of the type. Make sure one side of the fixture is connected to Live (L) and the other side to Neutral (N).

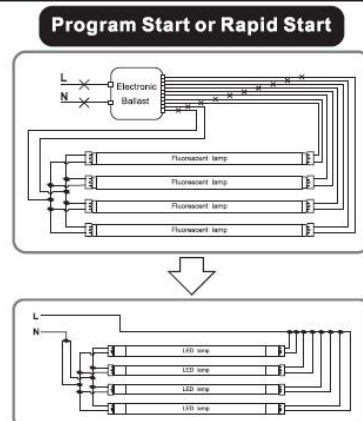
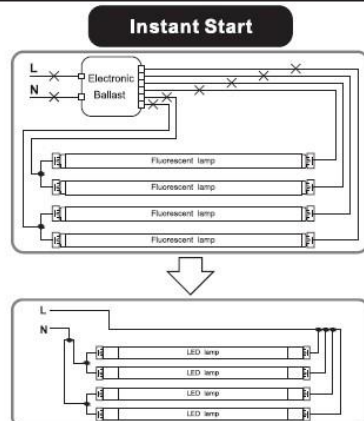
#### Retrofit luminaire with 1 lamp
